Preparation of the Gospel of Peace

Eph 6:10-14 Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. **Stand therefore**, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; **And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;**

A. What is the Gospel of Peace?

1. God is a holy God (Ps 99:9); sin broke fellowship with God. Gen 3:7-10;
2. Cannot have fellowship with God where sin has dominion. Rom 3:20; 5:20; 7:9
3. Jesus became sin for you so that you could be made righteous. 2 Cor 5:21
4. If you believe Jesus died and rose from the dead; you are a new creation. 1 Thes 4:14; 2 Cor 5:17
5. Being justified by faith you have peace with God. Rom 5:1

B. How to Do the Preparation of the Gospel of Peace.

1. Study to show your self approved, rightly dividing the word of truth. 2 Tim 2:15
2. Study with the mind set of passing on to faithful men who are able to teach others. 2 Tim 2:2
3. Know the Word so as to be quick to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves. 2 Tim 2:24-25
4. Preach the word; **be instant in season**, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. 2 Tim 4:2
5. Know that you know that grace and peace are multiplied through the knowledge of God and Jesus Christ. 2 Pet 1:2

C. Results of the Preparation of the Gospel of Peace.

1. You live prosperous and successful. Josh 1:8
2. You walk in the way of peace. Luk 1:79
3. How beautiful are the feet of them that bring gospel of Peace. Rom 10:15
4. You are an ambassador for Christ. 2 Cor 5:20
5. The God of Peace will bruise satan's head under your feet. You will trample on serpents and scorpions (demons). Luk 10:19
Rom 16:20

D. How is Peace our Defense?

1. Jesus left you His peace. Do not let your heart be troubled. John 14:27
2. Let peace rule in your heart. Col 3:15
3. Peace of God guards your heart and mind. Phil 4:6-7
4. Right living causes you to be at peace with your enemies. Prov 16:7
5. Love God's law and nothing shall offend you. Psa 119:165
