| a) Born again into the family of God, you are blessed with all that you will ever need or desire. Your blessings manifest in the natural as you do things God's way. | Eph 1:3

| 2) Ambassador of Heaven | |
| a) As you tell people about Jesus, you loose into your life the manifested blessings of God because the power of God is in the Gospel. | Pro 11:30

| 3) Spiritual Power as a Priest | |
| a) As you learn more and more to pray the mysteries of God, the powers of Heaven and the angels of God are released by your words, and the devil will flee from you. | Heb 5:14

| 4) Material Power as a King | |
| a) As wealth & riches grow in your life (Ps 112:3), you will have increasing power over people & circumstances of life. Even the heathen and stranger will obey you. | Psa 115:14

| 5) Disciple of Jesus Christ | |
| a) As you continue in the Word, you are set free from every bondage and become a super-conqueror over every worldly challenge. | John 8:32

C. Know Your Responsibilities

| 1) As an adult in the family of God, you have the responsibility of "Noblesse Oblige" (i.e., the Obligation of Royalty to plan for, care for, protect and nurture others). | Rom 8:14-17 |
| a) Requirements of Nobility. | |
| • Privilege entails responsibility. | |
| • Whoever claims to be noble, must conduct himself nobly. | |
| • One must act in a fashion that conforms to one's position. | |
| b) Freely you have received, freely give. | Matt 10:8a |
| c) To him who is given much, much is required. | Luke 12:48 |
| 2) You have the responsibility to learn to use the Name of Jesus and exercise its authority over all principality, power, might, dominion and everything with a name. | Eph 2:6

| 3) You have been made an Ambassador of Heaven to minister the Gospel of Reconciliation. | 2 Co 5:17-18 |
| 4) As an Ambassador of Heaven, you represent Jesus Christ: | |
| a) To tell people that God is not angry at them and that they can go to Heaven. | John 16:8,9 |
| b) To minister life, healing, deliverance and provision to those who are in need. | Matt 10:8b |
| c) To live out the plan that God has for your life. | Jer 29:11 |
| 5) As an Ambassador of Heaven, you may be all of Jesus that some on earth might ever see. | Gal 2:20 |

D. Know Your Benefits as an Ambassador of Heaven

- 1) You have authority and dominion in three worlds: the spiritual above and around you, the natural or physical world around you, and the underworld of satan. Phil 2:10

- 2) Everything is subject to change because everything (except people) is subject to you:
 - a) Except by choice, you are subject to nothing and to nobody. Rom 4:17
Matt 6:24
 - b) All authority comes from God and so you are obedient to authority as long as that authority is not being used in an ungodly manner. John 19:11
 - c) You are complete in Him, and He has provided everything that you need to escape the challenges and lusts of this world Col 2:9,10
2 Pet 1:3,4

- 3) You have diplomatic immunity
 - a) You can live above destruction and death because the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the Law of Sin and Death. Rom 8:2
 - b) Nothing of the enemy can by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19
 - c) The angels protect you from all harm lest you even dash your foot against a stone. Psa 91:5-12
 - d) Affirm: “In the Name of Jesus, the angels of God protect me from all evil coming from the kingdom of men, the kingdom of darkness, the kingdom of animals and the kingdom of nature.”
 - e) Affirm: “In the Name of Jesus, every germ, disease, virus, parasite, bacteria, micro-organism, fungus or mold, which is potentially harmful to me, dies on contact with my body or clothes.”
 - f) Affirm: “In the Name of Jesus, every chemical, drug, poison, allergen or radiation, potentially harmful to me, is neutralized on contact with my body or clothes.”

- 4) You can create your world (Heb 11:3) by calling things that be not as though they were. Rom 4:17
 - a) Nothing is impossible for you. Matt 17:20
 - b) The things that Jesus did, you can do and greater. John 14:12
 - c) Whatever you ask (*demand for use as an ambassador*) in the Name of Jesus, He will give it to you and, if He does not have it, He will make it for you John 14:14
 - d) The angels of God are here to minister (i.e., be servants--Matt 20:26-27) to you. Heb 1:14
 - e) You can call on the armies of Heaven (Matt 26:53), for you serve Jehovah-Tzvaot. Mal 3:11

- 5) You live as an ambassador:
 - a) By the authority and power in the **Name of Jesus**. Phil 2:9-11
 - b) By using **your faith in His name** to release that authority and power. Acts 3:16
 - c) **By speaking** in His Name in faith to command the end results which you desire. Mark 16:17-20
 - d) By you living as the ambassador that God has empowered you to be:
 - A mountain-mover. Mark 11:23
 - An earth-shaker. Acts 16:22-26
 - A giant-killer. 1 Sa 17:45-50
