

## The Anointing in You

**Overview:** The Anointing destroys the yoke by confirming the Word when it is spoken in faith out of a heart of faith.

### A. The Anointing and the Word

The Anointing is the power of God manifested for a specific purpose.

1. The Word does not function by itself.
  - a) The Written Word and the Word in your heart must agree. Rom 10:8
  - b) The engrafted Word delivers your soul. Jam 1:21
  - c) If there is iniquity in your heart, God can't hear you. Psalm 66:18
  - d) If your heart doesn't condemn you, whatsoever you ask, you receive. 1 John 3:20-22
2. The Word works with the Anointing of God.
  - a) Light be; and the Spirit of God moved. Gen 1:2,3
  - b) God said, "Let us create man; & breathed into man the breath of life." Gen 1:26; 2:7
  - c) Confess with your mouth; born of water and Spirit. Rom 10:9; John 3:5,6
  - d) The Word was made flesh; Spirit remaining on Him. John 1:14, 33; 2:11
  - e) Bind the strong man; Anointing destroys the yoke. Matt 12:29; Isa 10:27
3. Faith connects the Word with the Anointing.
  - a) Word of Faith is nigh; we began in the Spirit, continue in faith. Rom 10:8; Gal 3:2-3
  - b) As He was teaching, the power was present to heal. Luke 5:17
  - c) Woman (with issue), thy faith has made thee whole. Mark 5:34
  - d) Taught in synagogue but could do no mighty work. Mark 6:2,5,6
  - e) The Word was not mixed with faith. Heb 4:2
  - f) Hearers and not doers deceive themselves. James 1:22

### B. God's Glory is the Anointing in You

The Anointing resides in you, the spirit man.

1. God's Glory is in you.
  - a) You are the temple of God, and the Spirit of God dwells in you. 1Co 3:16
  - b) Hidden mystery is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Col 1:26,27
  - c) The same Spirit Who raised Christ from the dead quickens your flesh. Rom 8:11
  - d) The anointing abides in you. 1 John 2:27
  - e) Our Father wants you filled with the fullness of God. Eph 3:19
  - f) Know the riches of His glory in the saints. Eph 1:17
2. The Anointing changes you from the inside outward.
  - a) You, the spirit, have a heart, soul and mind and live in a body. Matt 22:37
  - b) Renew your mind by studying the Word. Rom 12:2
  - c) Put the Word in your heart by doing it. James 1:25
  - d) Live in accordance with His teachings i.e., continue in the Word. John 8:31
  - e) Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks. Matt 12:34
  - f) The heart teaches the mouth and tongue. Pro 16:23
  - g) Whosoever keeps his tongue, keeps his soul. Pro 21:23
  - h) In your patience, you shall possess your soul. Luke 21:19
  - i) A wholesome tongue is a tree of life. Pro 15:4

3. You release the Anointing by speaking and touching.
  - a) You have enough faith to change anything. Mark 11:24,23,22
  - b) Gospel is the power of God unto salvation. Romans 1:16
  - c) We speak the wisdom of God unto glory. 1 Cor 2:5,7
  - d) If ye abide in Me and My Words abide in you. John 15:7
  - e) Lay hands on the sick and they recover. Mark 16:18
  - f) Live in unity with God. Jesus said, "Ye in me and I in you." John 14:20

### C. The Anointing Raises You from Glory to Glory

Let the anointing flow out of your spirit through your heart to flood your entire being and world.

1. The goal is to live in holiness.
  - a) Be perfect and holy as Your Father is. Matt 5:48; 2 Cor 7:1
  - b) Be perfect in Jesus. Col 1:28
  - c) He has already made you perfect. Heb 10:14
  - d) In Him dwells the fullness of the Godhead; and you are complete in Him. Col 2:9,10
  - e) So you are a super-conqueror. Rom 8:37
2. The process is to remain in the Kingdom of God.
  - a) Seek the Kingdom and all will be added unto you. Rom 14:17
  - b) He has already given us all spiritual blessings. Matt 6:33
  - c) He does for us exceeding abundantly above all we can ask or think. Eph 1:3
  - d) Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Eph 3:20
  - e) The believer overcomes the world. Matt 6:10
  - f) Much more shall we reign in life. 1 John 5:5
3. The result is to be conformed to the image of Jesus.
  - a) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord. Rom 8:29
  - b) We are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 2 Cor 3:18
  - c) By precious promises, we might be partakers of His divine nature. 1 Peter 1:5
  - d) When His glory shall be revealed, you may have exceeding joy. 2 Peter 1:3-5
  - e) When He appears, we shall be like Him. 1 Peter 4:13
  - f) You are gods (e.g., free will makes you captain of your own ship). 1 John 3:1,2
  - g) Jesus said, "He called them gods and the Scriptures cannot fail." Psalm 82:6
  - h) Satan became the god of this world when Adam sinned. John 10:34,35
  - i) Today, satan is under your feet. What does that make you? 2 Cor 4:4
  - j) You are an ambassador of Christ. Eph 2:6 & 1:20-21
