

## Creating Your World with Your Words

### A. Your Words Create

- 1) You are made in the image of God. Gen 1:26
  - a) God is creative; therefore, so are you. Gen 1:18
  - b) “And God said” ten times. He spoke into existence that which He desired; you should also speak into existence that which you desire. Gen 1
  - c) The Israelites in the wilderness also spoke ten times, bringing their own death into manifestation. Num 14:22
- 2) Your tongue controls all the issues of your life.
  - a) Guard your heart with all diligence, for out of it flow all the issues of life. Pro 4:23
  - b) From the abundance of your heart, your mouth speaks to define the issues of life. Matt 12:34
  - c) Elijah lived because He called fire down from heaven on his enemies. 2 King 1:10
- 3) Death and life are in the power of your tongue. Pro 18:21
  - a) Live and not die to declare the works of the Lord. Psa 118:17
  - b) Your tongue is a tree of life. Pro 15:4
  - c) Elisha lived because his prayers resulted in the enemy’s army being blinded. 2 Ki 6:15-18
- 4) You have what you say. Mark 11:23
  - a) **You create by calling things that be not as though they are.** You affirm them until they manifest (appear) in your life. Rom 4:17
  - b) The Book of the Law must always be in your mouth to create success and prosperity. Josh 1:8
  - c) Jesus blessed the meal and fed 5000 (Matt 14:16-21); and then, 4000. Matt 15:32-38
- 5) You are an overcomer through the words of your mouth.
  - a) You overcome by the Blood of the Lamb and the word of your testimony. Rev 12:11
  - b) You can do all things through Christ (Phil 4:13) if you only believe it and declare it. Mark 5:36
  - c) David slew Goliath because he declared his covenant with God and said that he would cut off Goliath’s head. 1 Sam 17:45

### B. Your Words Frame (i.e., Order)

- 1) God framed the world with His Words(i.e., He created order out of chaos with His words). Heb 11:3
  - a) He separated the light from the darkness with His Word. Gen 1:4
  - b) He brought order by saying 9 times that everything would produce after its own kind. Gen 1
  - c) In the New Covenant, He puts it this way, “Give and it shall be given unto you.” Luke 6:38
- 2) God told Adam to dress (order) and keep (maintain or protect) the Garden of Eden. Gen 2:15
  - a) Adam had been given authority over everything that moved upon the earth. Gen 1:28
  - b) All Adam had to do to protect the garden was to speak the words of authority. Luke 10:17
  - c) Jesus demonstrated what Adam should have done, when He told satan to go away. Matt 4:10
- 3) Jesus ordered His life by saying only what He heard the Father say. John 8:26,28
  - a) We are followers of Christ, so let us do the same.
  - b) We desire to be more Christ-like, so let us do the things that He did & greater works. Jn 14:12
- 4) Elijah restored order with his words.
  - a) He started a drought and famine, and he ended the drought with prayer. 1 Kin 18:41
  - b) He defeated the enemy, ending a siege and a terrible famine by his declarations. 2 Kin 7:1-18
- 5) The spiritual world and its laws supersede those of the natural; **order** is enforcing this.
  - a) You are to frame your world by enforcing health, prosperity and other blessings. Matt 10:8
  - b) You frame (i.e., order) the blessings in your life by saying about yourself what God says about you. Jam 1:21
  - c) **You order your life by loosing the blessings into your life.** Matt 12:37

### C. Your Words Uphold (i.e., Maintain)

| b) Joshua maintained his victory in the battle by stopping the sun with his word.  | Josh 6:20     |
| c) Israel has had to uphold (i.e., maintain) their land by continuous battles, even to now.  | Josh 10:12    |
| 4) You uphold (i.e., maintain) your life by declaring that He is your refuge and your fortress, your God in Whom you will trust.                                   | Psa 91:2      |
| a) They could not kill Paul until he had run his race and was ready to be offered up.  | 2 Tim 4:6     |
| b) The church prayed and Peter in prison was set free from certain death by an angel.  | Acts 12:7     |
| 5) You are blessed with everything that you need for today and for your life, but you need to maintain it.   | 2 Pet 1:3     |
| a) <b>You uphold (i.e., maintain) health, prosperity, protection and victory by doing maintenance affirmations (i.e., by affirming the Word of God regularly).</b> | Tit 3:8       |
| b) You uphold (i.e., maintain) the blessings in your life by binding satan & his demons.   | Matt 18:18    |
