**Living Until Jesus Returns Part 1**

**Overview:** You can live a life of quality until you are satisfied with the length of your days.

- (1) Why do people think that they have to die?
- a) Experience: Their history tells them that people die.
    - But as you believe, so shall you receive.
  - b) Science: Actuarial tables list life expectancies.
    - But science teaches all cells replaced every 7 years
  - c) All the apostles died.
    - But they were willing to die - Stephen (Acts 7:59); Paul (2 Tim 4:6)
  - d) Aging is associated with deterioration and death, 2 Cor 4:16
    - But you are a new creation 2 Cor 5:17
    - But you are walking in newness of life Rom 6:3-4 Ampl
  - e) It is appointed for each to die once. Heb 9:27
    - But how about Enoch and Elijah?
    - But Lazarus and many others died more than once.
    - But you are really a spirit, which died once and was born again.
- (2) What does God think about “not dying”?
- a) God’s will for your life
    - We are made in the image of God Gen 1:26
    - Adam was created to live forever Gen 2:9, 16,17
    - In Heaven, we will live with him forever Rev 22:5
    - Today, Thy will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven Matt 6:10
    - Tree of life in Eden and in Heaven Gen 3:22; Rev 22:2
    - Today, your tongue is a tree of life Pro 15:4
  - b) God’s purpose for your life
    - The wages of sin is death Rom 6:23
    - Men shall have 120 years Gen 6:3
    - Children of disobedience live 70-80 years Psa 90:10
    - Fear of the Lord .... Years of wicked shortened Pro 10:27
    - With long life will He satisfy you. Psa 91:16
- (3) What you think about it will determine how long you live.
- a) As you believe, so shall you receive Mark 11:24; Matt 8:13
    - Jesus became sin, so you are the righteousness of God. 2 Cor 5:21; 1 Pet 2:24
    - Jesus took sickness, so you are the healed of the Lord. Is 53:4,5
    - Jesus became poor that you might be rich. 2 Cor 8:9
    - Jesus died so that you don’t have to die. Heb 2:9
  - b) This is my body; This is my blood 1 Cor 11:24-25; Matt 26:28-29
  - c) You are what you eat. All of Him and none of you. John 6:47-51
  - d) Be petrified with the Rock of your Salvation Rom 8:29
  - e) If ye abide in Me and My Words abide in you John 15:7
  - f) Choose life not death Deut 30:19
  - g) Your tongue is a tree of life Pro 15:4
