Homework Assignments

1. Read all the handouts and check the Scriptures.
2. Choose something in your life in the physical realm (but not your body nor demonic spirits) to continue to practice authority. Each week over the next month, exercise your dominion at least five days (not times) over “the earth or every living thing that moves upon it.” Gen 1:26-28. Choose at least one different item each day and keep affirming the results of your Prayer of Authority until you receive either the manifestation or it is time to write your printed report. From the entire month’s activity, choose two of these events and turn in a **printed** praise report of no more than ½ of a page on each item. If any printed report is longer than ½ a page per report, it will probably be returned to you for editing.
3. Choose something in your life that has to do with you; your emotions, your habits, or your body and practice authority over at least 4 separate items. Choose at least 1 different item each week and keep affirming the results of your Prayer of Authority until you receive either the manifestation or it is time to write your printed report. Choose two of these events and turn in a **printed** praise report of no more than ½ of a page on each item.
4. On a daily basis, pray the Three Witness Anointing Prayer over yourself. One by one, apply each element to your forehead. Each time, after anointing your forehead with an element, speak out the matching Three Witnesses prayer; and in each prayer include your heart, soul, mind, brain, memory, five senses, tongue, vocal cords, every cell, every organ and every system in your body. If you choose to, you may cast out the demons, devils and evil spirits as you are praying through the Three Witness Anointing Prayer or you may choose to simply wash them down and shut them up.
5. On a daily basis affirm each of the following affirmations **50 times**: From 1 Cor 2:16, “In the Name of Jesus, I have the mind of Christ.” From

Psa 19:14, “In the Name of Jesus, God has made the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart acceptable to Him.” From Rom 6:11, “In the Name of Jesus, I reckon myself dead to sin, but alive unto God.”
