| 3) The Blood of Jesus – used to speak to the satanic beings. | Heb 12:24 |
| 4) Prayer of Affirmations – used to agree with God by declaring God’s truth regarding the defeat of satan and his minions. | Tit 3:8 |
| 5) Prayer of Binding and Loosing – used to loose God’s will, power and angels and to bind up the enemy forces. | Matt 18:18 |
| 6) Casting out – used to rid bodies and places of devils, demons and evil spirits. | Mark 16:17 |
| 7) Praise including dancing, body praise and lifting up holy hands. | |
| a) God inhabits the praises of His people. | Psa 22:3 |
| b) Praise stills the avenger (Matt 21:16) | Psa 8:2 |

C. Weapons of Defense

| 1) The Shield of Faith. – used to protect the mind from fiery darts by rejecting the lies of circumstance and demons. | Eph 6:16 |
| 2) Confessing sins – used to accept the forgiveness in your salvation package by repenting of sins which were committed since the last act of repentance. | 1 John 1:9 |
| 3) The Blood of Jesus – used to cover yourself, your loved ones & your possessions. | Heb 9:12-14 |
| 4) Prayer of Affirmations – used to agree with God’s promises regarding the health, wealth and possessions of yourself and your family. | Heb 10:23
Psa 35:27 |
| 5) Breaking curses – used to remove from you and your family the tentacles and snares of past personal and generational sins. | Lev 15:32 |
| 6) Worship – used to put yourself into alignment and to move yourself into the Holy of Holies in order to hear God’s voice more clearly. | John 9:31
2 Chr 5:13-14 |
| 7) Reading the Bible aloud. – used to drive demons and evil spirits away from you. | Jam 4:7 |
